

Certified Nursing Assistant Training Information *(Harrison)*

Petra Allied Health's nursing assistant program is the 90 hour class required by the State of Arkansas to become a certified nursing assistant.

Day classes start every two weeks and meet three days a week for one month (except for the second week of class which meets Monday through Friday). **You can choose between classes that meet Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, or Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Evening Classes meet Monday through Thursday. Most students taking this course utilize the sponsorship program, allowing them to go to work after the first week of class and have their tuition paid by a sponsoring facility. The student in return is committed to work for the sponsor (with pay) for a minimum of three months. Some sponsors may require a longer commitment.

Students must be at least 16 years old and not have a disqualifying criminal record (sponsors are required to obtain background checks) in order to be eligible for sponsorship.

Classes will meet at Vine Court Square, 702 N. Main, Suite 1-A (right behind the hospital). There is no pre-registration; students may register at the first day of class.

Day classes meet 8:00a to 2:30p with the following starting and graduating days/dates.
